ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIONS OF UNITS TO FORM THE 76TH FIELD ARTILLERY REGIMENT UNDER THE U.S. ARMY REGIMENTAL SYSTEM (USARS)

- 1. The 76th Field Artillery regiment will be WITHDRAWN from the Combat Arms Regimental System and REORGANIZED under the U.S. Army Regimental System, effective 16 February 1987.
- 2. HHB, 1st Bn, 76th Field Artillery, UIC: WE9ZAA will be REORGANIZED and REDESIGNATED as Btry A, 76th Field Artillery, UIC: WE9ZAA under MTOE 6-398JE101, E10187 with the following strengths: STSTR: 6 OFF, 125 ENL, 131 AGG-AUSTR: 6 OFF, 125 ENL, 131 AGG and remains ASSIGNED to the 3d Infantry Division in Germany, effective 16 February 1987.
- 3. The remaining organic batteries of the 1st Bn, 76th Field Artillery will be INACTIVATED effective 16 February 1987.
