## TRANSFER AND REDESIGNATION OF UNITED STATES ARMY ELEMENT, COMMANDER'S STAFF MULTINATIONAL FORCE AND OBSERVERS (MFO)

- 1. Effective 16 October 2000, the mission, functions, and resources associated with the UNITED STATES ARMY ELEMENT, COMMANDER'S STAFF MULTINATIONAL FORCE AND OBSERVERS (UIC: W4JQAA), Sinai, Egypt are transferred from HEADQUARTERS, UNITED STATES MILITARY OBSERVER GROUP—WASHINGTON (UIC: W489AA) to U.S. ARMY FORCES COMMAND (UIC: 3WYBAA).
- 2. The Secretary of Defense designated the Secretary of the Army as the Executive Agent for this mission on 22 October 1981. Performance of missions and functions in the above paragraph will continue to be subject to the oversight of the Secretary of the Army. The Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Plans through the Commander, U.S. Military Observer Group—Washington will continue as the staff agent with MFO oversight.
- 3. Effective 16 October 2000, the UNITED STATES ARMY ELEMENT, COMMANDER'S STAFF MULTINATIONAL FORCE AND OBSERVERS (UIC: W4JQAA) is redesignated the UNITED STATES ARMY TASK FORCE SINAI (UIC: W4JQAA).
